Mandir is there to service the spiritual needs of devotees and we intend to do just that. In the long run trustees wish to extend the Mandir as a "community centre". A list of <u>the</u> forthcoming events <u>is included</u> in this newsletter. We have a regular weekly highlight on Thursday Bhajans and Saturday "<u>21</u> Hanuman Chalisa". Both events are followed by "Prasad". We are glad to state that attendances have been increasing.

On 25<sup>th</sup> December <u>2008</u> we had Bhajans from <u>well known bapa devotee</u>, Valjibhai Dawda of Jalaram Matru Seva Mandal. We also recited <u>"108</u> Hanuman Chalisa" on <u>the new years day</u>. Organising all <u>the</u> activities including Prasad for such a high number of devotees in a small place like our Mandir is a <u>big</u> task which <u>require</u> lot of resources. We are grateful to volunteers who devote their time on a regular basis to make the events of the Mandir a success.

In the coming months, we intend to increase our regular activities. Currently we have a ladies afternoon on Mondays and Wednesdays. Resources permitting, we would like to organise Gujarati classes for our youths and English classes for the elderly. We would like to appeal to volunteers to come forward for this task.
